PROVISIONAL TREE PRESERVATION ORDER HOME FARM, OLD GREAT NORTH ROAD, GREAT CASTERTON

The Parish Council would like to object to the Provisional Tree Preservation Order for the two Common Lime trees at Home Farm, Great Casterton. In doing this we thoroughly endorse and agree all the points made in Mr. Lamb's letter to Rutland County Council dated 22nd June 2016.

In particular the Council disputes that these trees have a significant public amenity value and it is recommended that they be replaced by new trees, if necessary under a Tree Replacement Notice, in accordance with Government Planning Practice.

This will certainly improve a depressed section of the Conservation Area, which the Parish Council is trying to clear up.
