Highways and Transport Working Group Representation

Great Casterton Parish Council would like the following Representation be considered at this meeting.

Reference. ITCP 2018-11 Great Casterton

The Parish Council has made a number of representations about the top end of Water Lane which is very narrow and causes congestion at the crossroads, particularly at school opening and closing times. These are well tabulated in the Agenda for the 25th February meeting.

Since these comments were made the Parish Council has contacted the Land Registry from whom copies of entries relating to no. 23 Main Strreet and the neighbouring property, which show that there are covenants in the Deeds of No 23 and of the sheds (the land of which comes across the front of No 23). These covenants give the County Council (without payment) a strip of 6 feet in front and down the side of No 23 for the purpose of widening the road. Copies of these documents are attached for your examination.

It is assumed that when these covenants were drawn up the then Planning/Highways Departments had agreed that only the top end of the lane as far as the present new entrance should be widened. The present Parish Council agrees with that decision and recommends that Rutland County Council considers adding this to their Highways works programme.
